February 2024 BAHC meeting minutes

Old business:

It was discussed and decided that we would not have a club presence at the 2024 Autorama due to weather concerns since most members don't have access to enclosed trailers. New Business:

- Since Jim Thornton's membership profile was such a success we asked for a volunteer for a member profile for this month, and Larry Jensen volunteered. Thanks Larry we look forward to your story.
- 2. There was some discussion about still needing a current "Delegate" to represent the club at the annual AHCA meeting. Larry Jensen offered to fill this position and he was accepted, thanks again Larry. This meeting is only once a year and can be attended through a "Zoom" link online. It was decided that this would be a rotating position and a new delegate would be appointed every year. The delegate is responsible for filling out 2 one-page forms. One is a financial report, and the second one describes what the club has been doing over the past year, such as tech sessions, drives, events attended etc..
- 3. One of the main events that the club will be promoting this year will be a "Time, Speed, Distance Rally". Henry will be leading the charge on putting this together. This year we are considering trying something new by purchasing the "Richta App" that is GPS related. It will allow us to not have people stationed at different check points and the rally participants to be monitored from a personal computer. Once again Larry has stepped up and volunteered to write up instructions on how to use the Richta App. We have a commitment from the Jaguar Club and the BMCU to participate.
- 4. BMCU hosts a number of events and they have been scheduled for the year, (see below). The dates and the name of the events are at the end of this email. Please post it on your calendars as a reminder.
- 5. The club plans to attend the "Brigham City Peach Days" car show in hopes of exposing our club to more people. We are also hoping to attract some new members. This is the weekend after Labor Day, Sept 7th, 2024.
- 6. We discussed having a driving season opening event, sometime in May. What we would do is meet somewhere, to be determined, in the Salt Lake City area, have a short drive, 1-1-1/2 hours and all go out for BRUNCH!! Since you are out in your car already you may as well go for a scenic drive. Route to be determined or you can choose to head home. It will be a fun way to blow the dust off of your car.
- 7. Here is another idea that you may like. The club would have an "ANNUAL MILEAGE AWARD". A notice will be sent out to all members at the beginning

of the year requesting that you take a picture of the mileage on your speedometer. Those pictures will be emailed in to one of the club officers, probably the "Activity Coordinator". Then at the end of November you take another picture of your speedometer and email that in. The pictures will be compared and mileage tallied. The member that has driven the most miles for the year will be given a "Mileage Award Trophy" at the Christmas party. You keep the award for the coming year, and since we will have your November mileage all you have to do is take another picture the next November and send it in. Hopefully this will stimulate us to get out and drive our cars and foster a bit of friendly competition among members.

- 8. Don Hughes is ordering repair parts for his door that we worked on at the 2/10 tech session. When parts arrive, a new session will be scheduled.
- 9. Our club has a wonderland of knowledge in our members that has been developed through years of experience. It was suggested that this knowledge could be passed around by means of a "Teaching Tech Class" where we pick a set topic and teach fellow members some of the skills needed to keep our cars on the road. Topics might include, preventative maintenance and winterizing, metal repair and body work, transmission/engine repair, tube bending, carburetor rebuilding, electrical trouble shooting, etc.
